In episode one, the class visits the inside of an anthill to learn about ant anatomy and behavior. They discover the roles of forager ants, guard ants, nurse ants, larvae, pupae, builder ants, and the queen ant. Episode two looks at the insect society of bees as the children learn about the behavior of honeybees, how bees communicate by dancing, and how nectar becomes honey.
